-Concert Band & Jazz Band Trip Details-

The CONCERT BAND & JAZZ BAND TRIP/PERFORMANCE is Saturday December 10th, and here are the details.....

*I will do my best to cover the main points. We have done this trip many times and it usually goes with no problems. Please be flexible when it comes to “times” and the “directions”. Due to safety and security, I must follow the policies set by Universal Studios/Islands of Adventure, Clay County Schools, and the Charter Bus company.

****This is a band trip, so all band members & chaperones will stay together, or in groups, from 5am until we return around 9:45pm that night....**

Here we go! :

1. **Saturday- December 10th** - students & chaperones report to the band room by 5:00am for warm-up and loading. Each band will perform on the stage of the Citywalk. After the performances, students will change out of their nice shoes and nice pants and into something school appropriate for the parks- **THEY MUST KEEP THEIR BAND POLO ON AT ALL TIMES!** Students will get into their chaperone groups and enjoy the parks for the day. We will leave Universal area at 7pm. **We will be back to the school around 9:45pm.** I will have the kids call home using cell phones as we get closer.

2. That morning (5am)- Students arrive in uniform: black pants, black dress shoes, black socks, and the band polo. They can change after the performances, but they must leave the band shirt on! School dress code is required! (see #1 above)

→Students must stay with their assigned Chaperoned group while on this trip.←

Also: If a student does not want to participate on a ride, they can wait at the ‘holding area’ where the rest of the group departs/returns from the ride ☺

If there are behavior issues on this trip, the parent will be called to come and pick-up your child ASAP from Orlando.

3. **\$\$Each student will need money\$\$.** ONE meal is provided. So, give them cash for other food and souvenirs. Everyone in a group must stay together at all times.
