****Attention 2023-2024: 6th Grade Parents & Students! --- The last 5 years were a success! So, we are again offering an after school Beginning Band for the 6th graders that attend OVE, POE, and DOE.***

→ This is for the students who will be attending Oakleaf Jr High as 7th graders for the 2024-2025 school year. This is an opportunity for a 6th grader to get a head start on learning a band instrument & reading music; and we are preparing these students for our band program when they come over full-time as 7th & 8th graders.

Here is what we need from the families interested:

****STEP 1: Take the time to CLICK THE LINK BELOW & READ the info about this 'after school' class and the expectations. There are details for being a part of the band program (general info, calendar, fees, etc). After you have taken the time to look over the info below (and above); then decide whether or not to proceed with the next 'STEPS'. →Link: www.oakleafband.com***

****STEP 2: July 24th (Monday) ---OR--- July 25th (Tuesday) from 9am-12pm - INSTRUMENT FITTING ☺ Your student will be evaluated and fitted for the best instrument for them that they like. Parents- please park your vehicle and come into the band room during the instrument fitting session. You will need to sign some stuff. The band room is located at the front of the school between the front office and cafeteria. LOOK FOR SIGNS!***

****STEP 3: Once the student has been fitted, they will be required to attend the class every Monday & Tuesday from 4:00-5pm / starting August 14-15th. No class when there is a school holiday. Concert rehearsals and performances are also required. Band fees are required as well. The info about the calendar & fees is located in the packet (link above in STEP 1).***

→*Disclaimer: Throughout the school year, a re-assessment might be needed if the student is struggling to 'keep up' with the group and the required assignments. A recommendation to stop and start again when they come to the jr high full-time might be given.
